

ORDER

WHEREAS, in view of the assessment of the traffic situation in the aftermath of collapse of the Majherhat Bridge on 04.09.2018, the issue of regulation of heavy goods traffic bears utmost priority at present;

AND

WHEREAS, I, Anuj Sharma, Commissioner of Police, Kolkata being an Executive Magistrate for the Metropolitan area of Kolkata as well as in the district of South 24 Parganas (within the limits of the suburbs of Kolkata falling under Kolkata Police jurisdiction) as appointed and specially empowered by the State Govt. under the Notification No. 03- P.S. Cell/HR/O/3P-13/05 dated 02.01.2020 read with the Notification No. 01- P.S. Cell/HR/O/3P-13/05 dated 02.01.2020 and the Notification No. 04-P.S.Cell/HR/O/3P-13/05 dated 02.01.2020 read with the Notification No. 02-P.S.Cell/H.R./0/3P-13/05 dated 02.01.2020 to act under the sub-section (1) of Section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (Act 2 of 1974), am of the opinion that it is necessary to take steps to regulate goods vehicles having 20 (twenty) wheels or more to evade traffic congestion so as the larger public interest in smooth and nuisance free plying on the roads is maintained;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the power conferred by Sub Section (1) of Section 144 of the Code of Criminal procedure, 1973(Act 2 of 1974) read with the Sub Section (3) of the said Section, I, Anuj Sharma, Commissioner of Police, Kolkata being an Executive Magistrate for the Metropolitan area of Kolkata as well as in the district of South 24 Parganas (within the limits of the suburbs of Kolkata falling under Kolkata Police jurisdiction) do hereby order: -

Prohibiting all goods vehicles having 20 (twenty) wheels or more from entering in to or exiting from the entire Kolkata Police jurisdiction.


This order shall come into force with effect from **12.06.2020** and shall remain in force for a period of **60 (sixty) days** i.e., up to **10.08.2020** or until further order.

Any person contravening this order shall be punishable under the extant applicable provisions of law.

As the notice cannot be served individually upon all concerned, the order is hereby passed exparte under sub-section (2) of section 144 of the Code of the Criminal Procedure, 1973. It shall be published for information of public through Press, the Kolkata Police Gazette and by affixing copies on Notice Boards of the offices of the all Divisional Deputy Commissioners of Police, Deputy Commissioner of Police, Traffic Department, Kolkata, Deputy Commissioner of Police, Traffic (South), Kolkata, all the Police Stations and the Traffic Guards concerned and the offices of the Kolkata Municipal Corporation.
