Whereas it is necessary in the interest of public safety and convenience of the road users during rehabilitation of dilapidated brick sewer portion under Tram -Track surrounding premises no. 33, B.B. Gangully Street in ward no. 44 under Br-V, undertaken by the Kolkata Municipal Corporation, I, Manoj Kumar Verma, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Kolkata, in exercise of power vested in me under section 115,116,117,122 and 126 of M.V.Act, 1988, Section 62, 62(IB) of Calcutta Police Act. 1866, 39, 39 (1B) of Calcutta Subn. Police Act 1866 read with Rule No. 85,86,87, 88 and 93 of the Rules for the Regulation of Traffic in Kolkata and its suburbs and under Sub-Section (1) of Section 4 of the West Bengal Traffic Regulation Act, 1965(W.B. Act XV of 1965) read with Govt. of West Bengal Home (Transport) Deptt. order No. 7605-WT, dated 20th July, 1965 and Govt. of West Bengal in Transport Deptt. Notification No. 3363-WT/3M/34/99 dated the 29th April' 1999, do hereby order that vehicles, availing the referred stretch of road, will be diverted in the following manner:

Diversion Plan:

- Vehicles coming along Central Avenue (North to South) to avail B.B.Ganguly Street will be diverted further south from the crossing of B.B Ganguly Street/ C R Avenue to Dorina Crossing – RR Avenue – Netaji Statue – Old Court House Street – BBD Bag (South) or to GC Avenue – Mango lane – BBD Bag(South)from the crossing of C R Avenue and G C Avenue.
- Buses coming along C R Avenue from North and B B Ganguly Street (from Sealdah side) to avail B.B.Ganguly Street will be diverted further south from the crossing of B B Ganguly Street/CR Avenue to Dorina Crossing – RR Avenue – Netaji Statue – Old Court House Street – BBD Bag (South) or to Dorina Crossing – RR Avenue – Netaji Statue-Kingsway/Auckland Road-Strand Road.
- Vehicular traffic will also be diverted through arterial roads as and when required.

This will come into force from commencement of the work and will continue till completion of the proposed work.
