Whereas it is necessary in the interest of public safety and convenience of the road users during the construction of 7(seven) nos. manhole at different locations on Bankim Mukherjee Sarani in Ward No. 81 under Br. X, undertaken by the Kolkata Municipal Corporation, I, Vineet Kumar Goyal, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Kolkata, in exercise of power vested in me under section 115,116,117,122 and 126 of M.V.Act, 1988, Section 62, 62(1B) of Calcutta Police Act. 1866, 39, 39 (1B) of Calcutta Subn. Police Act 1866 read with Rule No. 85,86,87, 88 and 93 of the Rules for the Regulation of Traffic in Kolkata and its suburbs and under Sub-Section (1) of Section 4 of the West Bengal Traffic Regulation Act, 1965(W.B. Act XV of 1965) read with Govt. of West Bengal Home (Transport) Dept. Order No. 7605-WT, dated 20th July, 1965 and Govt. of West Bengal in Transport Dept. Notification No. 3363-WT/3M/34/99 dated the 29th April' 1999, do hereby order that movement of East and West bound vehicular traffic of Bankim Mukherjee Sarani and movement of others vehicles of adjoining roads/lanes , will be made in the following manner:

1. East Bound Vehicle Diversion:

- Govt. Buses of Route No. S-4, AC-4A, S-22 & S-46 will be diverted from D H Road/ Sahapur Road Crossing to avail D H Road – Mominpore Crossing – Judges Court Road – Lalbati Crossing – Alipore Road – Chetla Central Road or Durgapur Bridge.
- Private Buses of Route No. 37, 18, 1B, 42B, SD-4, SD-5 & SD-76 will be diverted from D H Road/ Sahapur Road Crossing to avail D H Road – Mominpore Crossing – Judges Court Road – Lalbati Crossing – Alipore Road – Chetla Central Road or Durgapur Bridge.
- HGVs & MGVs will be diverted from D H Road/ Sahapur Road Crossing to avail D H Road – Mominpore Crossing – Judges Court Road – Lalbati Crossing – Alipore Road – Chetla Central Road or Durgapur Bridge.

2. West Bound Vehicle Diversion:

- Govt. Buses and Private Buses, availing west bound along Bankim Mukherjee Sarani from New Alipore Island, will be diverted from New Alipore Island to avail Durgapur Bridge – Alipore Road – Burdwan Road – D H Road – Jai Hind Bridge.
- HGVs & MGVs, availing west bound along Bankim Mukherjee Sarani from New Alipore Island, will be diverted from New Alipore Island to avail Durgapur Bridge – Alipore Road – Burdwan Road – D H Road – Jai Hind Bridge.

3. The vehicles will also be diverted through arterial roads as and when required.

4. These regulations will be enforced in addition to the other normal restrictions which are not repugnant to the above.

This will come into force from 22.00 Hrs on 25-05-2022 and will continue up to 06.00 hrs on 25-06-2022.
