Whereas it is necessary in the interest of public safety and convenience of the road users during 4<sup>th</sup> Phase demolition work of incomplete Vivekananda Flyover, undertaken by the Kolkata Metropolitan Development Authority, I, Vineet Kumar Goyal, Commissioner of Police, Kolkata, in exercise of power vested in me under section 115,116,117,122 and 126 of M.V. Act, 1988, Section 62, 62 (1B) of Calcutta Police Act. 1866, 39, 39 (1B) of Calcutta Subn. Police Act 1866 read with Rule No. 85, 86, 87, 88 and 93 of the Rules for the Regulation of Traffic in Kolkata and its suburbs and under Sub-Section (1) of Section 4 of the West Bengal Traffic Regulation Act, 1965(W.B. Act XV of 1965) read with Govt. of West Bengal Home (Transport) Dept. order No. 7605-WT, dated 20<sup>th</sup> July, 1965 and Govt. of West Bengal in Transport Dept. Notification No. 3363-WT/3M/34/99 dated the 29<sup>th</sup> April' 1999, do hereby order that circulation of traffic for closure of Malapara Crossing i.e., K K Tagore Street/ Jadulal Mallick Road Crossing, will be made in the following manners:

- East bound traffic of K K Tagore Street will be diverted from Strand Road/ K K Tagore Street Crossing towards North via Strand Road.
- South bound vehicles, availing Jadulal Mallick Road for Kalakar Street or Ganesh Talkies, will be diverted from Jadulal Mallick Road/Dwarpa Narayan Tagore Street Crossing to avail Dwarpa Narayan Tagore Street – Ganapat Bagla Road – K K Tagore Street towards East or Ratan Sarkar Garden Street – Kalakar Street.
- Buses/ Mini Buses, availing K K Tagore Street from Howrah Bridge side, will be diverted from Howrah Bridge East to avail M G Road as and when required.
- Buses of Route No. 215A and Mini Buses of Route No. 146, 180, 13, 185, 176, 189, 168, 20, 13A, 5 & 29, availing Jadulal Mallick Road south bound for Kalakar Street, will be diverted from C R Avenue/ J M Avenue Crossing to avail C R Avenue – M G Road – Howrah Bridge.
- At night HGVs will avail M D Road – Mirbahar Ghat Street – Strand Road/M G Road.
- Tram services of M G Road will be suspended during execution of the work.
- Vehicular traffic may also be diverted from any of the arterial and feeder roads by traffic police on duty as and when considered necessary.
- These regulations will be enforced in addition to the other normal restrictions on these days which are not repugnant to the above.

This will come into force immediately and will continue till completion of the proposed work.
