Whereas it is necessary in the interest of public safety and convenience for the work taken up by the HRBC Authority of rehabilitation of 2nd Hooghly Bridge including replacement of stay and holding down cables and bearing etc., I, Vineet Kumar Goyal, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Kolkata, in exercise of power vested in me under section 115,116,117,122 and 126 of M.V.Act, 1988, Section 62, 62(1B) of Calcutta Police Act. 1866, 39, 39 (1B) of Calcutta Subn. Police Act 1866 read with Rule No. 85,86,87, 88 and 93 of the Rules for the Regulation of Traffic in Kolkata and its suburbs and under Sub-Section (1) of Section 4 of the West Bengal Traffic Regulation Act, 1965(W.B. Act XV of 1965) read with Govt. of West Bengal Home (Transport) Deptt. Order No. 7605-WT, dated 20th July, 1965 and Govt. of West Bengal in Transport Deptt. Notification No. 3363-WT/3M/34/99 dated the 29th April' 1999, do hereby order that Heavy Goods Vehicles (HGVs) and Medium Goods Vehicles (MGVs), availing the Vidyasagar Setu (2nd Hooghly Bridge), will be diverted in the following manner:

Diversion Plan

- ❖ Movement of all types of HGVs and MGVs shall be restricted to ply along 2nd Hooghly Bridge (Vidyasagar Setu) from 01.11.2023.
- ❖ West bound HGVs and MGVs (except Port bound) coming along AJC Bose Road from D L Khan side for Vidyasagar Setu, will be diverted from AJC Bose Road / D L Khan Road Crossing to avail Hospital Road – K P Road – Dufferin Road – Mayo Road – Netaji Statue – Govt. Place East – Esplanade Row East – Esplanade Crossing – C R Avenue – Bhupen Bose Avenue – Shyambazar 5 Point Crossing – Tallah Bridge – B T Road – Dunlop Crossing - Nivedita Setu.
- ❖ West bound HGVs and MGVs (except Port bound) coming along AJC Bose Road from Exide Crossing for Vidyasagar Setu, will be diverted from Exide Crossing to avail J L Nehru Road – Dorina Crossing – Esplanade Crossing –C R Avenue – Bhupen Bose Avenue – Shyambazar 5 Point Crossing – Tallah Bridge– BT Road– Dunlop Crossing- Nivedita Setu.
- ❖ HGVs and MGVs, coming from Port area for Vidyasagar Setu, will be diverted from Clyde Row / St. Georges Gate Road crossing to avail St. Georges Gate Road – Strand Road - Kingsway–CR Das Statue- Netaji Statue – Govt. Place East – Esplanade Row East – Esplanade Crossing – CR Avenue - Bhupen Bose Avenue – Shyambazar 5 Point Crossing – Tallah Bridge–B T Road – Dunlop Crossing - Nivedita Setu.
- ❖ West bound HGVs and MGVs (except Port bound) coming along K P Road from J&N Island side for Vidyasagar Setu, will be diverted from 11 Furlong Gate towards Hastings Crossing to avail St. Georges Gate Road – Strand Road - Kingsway–C R Das Statue- Netaji Statue– Govt. Place East – Esplanade Row East Esplanade Crossing – CRAvenue - Bhupen Bose Avenue – Shyambazar 5 Point Crossing - Tallah Bridge – B T Road – Dunlop Crossing - Nivedita Setu.
- ❖ Vehicular traffic will also be diverted through arterial roads as and when required.
- ❖ These regulations will be enforced in addition to the other normal restrictions which are not repugnant to the above.

This will come into force from 01.11.2023 for 08 (eight) months.
