Whereas it is necessary in the interest of public safety and convenience in view of the traffic blockade, during partial closure along northern side of Bakrahat Road from D.H. Road crossing to 02 no. Bachar Para for construction of Five (05) shafts in connection with sewerage development work. I, Soumen Mitra, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Kolkata, in exercise of powers vested in me under section 115, 116, 117, 122 and 126 of M.V. Act, 1988, Section 62, 62(1B) of Calcutta Police Act 1866, 39, 39(1B) of Calcutta Suburban Police Act 1866 read with rule no. 85, 86, 87, 88 and 93 of the Rules for the Regulation of Traffic in Kolkata and its Suburbs and under sub-section (1) of Section 4 of the West Bengal traffic regulation Act, 1965 (W.B. Act XV of 1965) read with Govt. of West Bengal Home (Transport) Deptt. Order no. 7605-WT, Dated- 20th July 1965 and Govt. of West Bengal in Transport Deptt. Notification No. 3363-WT/3M/34/99, dated- the 29th April, 1999 do hereby order that vehicular circulation pattern for partial closure along northern side of Bakrahat Road from D.H. Road crossing to 02 no. Bachar Para, will be regulated/diverted in the following manner:-

Circulation Plan/Diversion of Buses, Goods vehicles & other big vehicles:

Busses: Public Buses route no 75 , SD-8 , Govt. Bus route Esplanade to Burul along with other big buses as well as HGV's and MGV's those intend to reach Khalpol from Thakurpukur Bazar (West bound) will avail further south along D.H. Road up to Ismail Sarani / D.H. Road crossing, then take right turn to avail Ismail Sarani and then Bakrahat Road. Similarly those vehicles which intend to reach Thakurpukur Bazar from Khalpole (East bound) will avail Ismail Sarani from Bakrahat Road, then take left turn from Ismail Sarani / D.H. Road crossing to avail D.H. Road north bound.

These will come into force with immediate effect and will continue till completion of the work.
