

TRAFFIC REGULATIONS

In view of the public safety and convenience in connection with **proposed repairing work of Chitpore Bridge**, I, Anuj Sharma, Commissioner of Police, Kolkata, in exercise of powers vested upon me under Section 115, 117, 122 & 126 M V Act, 1988 and Section 62, 62(1b) of Calcutta Police Act. 39, 39(1b) of Calcutta Suburban Police Act read with Rule No. 85, 86, 87, 88 & 93 of Rules for the Regulations of Traffic in Calcutta and Suburbs and under sub-section(1) of Section 4 of the West Bengal Traffic Regulations Act, 1965 (W B Act XV of 1965) read with Govt. of West Bengal Home (Transport) Department Order No. 7605-WT, dated the 20th July, 1965 and Govt. of West Bengal Transport Department Notification No. 3363-WT/3M- 34/99, dated the 29th April, 1999, do hereby order that movement of goods vehicles will be regulated on and from 23.02.2019 till completion of the work in the following manners:

1. Movement of Heavy Goods Vehicles over Chitpore Bridge will be restricted from 23.02.2019 till completion of the work.
2. North bound Heavy Goods Vehicles along KVV Avenue will not be allowed to avail Chitpur Bridge. Rather, the vehicles will be diverted via P K Mukherjee Road, Tala Bridge to avail B T Road.
3. South bound Heavy Goods Vehicles along B T Road, except the vehicles destined for Cossipore Railway Siding, will not be allowed to take right turn from Chiria More crossing. The vehicles will be diverted from Chiria More to ply along B T Road and Tala Bridge towards south.
4. These regulations shall be enforced in addition to the other normal restrictions on the days, which are not repugnant to the above.
