

TRAFFIC REGULATIONS

In view of the public safety and convenience in connection with **recommendation by Bridge Advisory Committee, KMDA to restrict the movement of heavy goods vehicles along Kalighat Bridge over Tolly's Nallah**, I, Anuj Sharma, Commissioner of Police, Kolkata, in exercise of powers vested upon me under Section 115, 117, 122 & 126 M V Act, 1988 and Section 62, 62(1b) of Calcutta Police Act. 39, 39(1b) of Calcutta Suburban Police Act read with Rule No. 85, 86, 87, 88 & 93 of Rules for the Regulations of Traffic in Calcutta and Suburbs and under sub-section(1) of Section 4 of the West Bengal Traffic Regulations Act, 1965 (W B Act XV of 1965) read with Govt. of West Bengal Home (Transport) Department Order No. 7605-WT, dated the 20th July, 1965 and Govt. of West Bengal Transport Department Notification No. 3363-WT/3M- 34/99, dated the 29th April, 1999, do hereby order that movement of goods vehicles will be regulated on and from 19.08.2019 till completion of the work in the following manners:

1. Movement of Heavy Goods Vehicles over Kalighat Bridge over Tolly's Nallah will be restricted from 19.08.2019 till completion of the work.
2. West bound heavy goods vehicles on Hazra Road will be diverted from S P M Road & Hazra Crossing along S P M Road further North or South.
3. South bound heavy goods vehicles on Harish Mukherjee Road will be diverted from Hazra Road & Harish Mukherjee Road Crossing to further East or South.
4. East bound heavy good vehicles along Judges Court Road will be diverted from Alipore Road & Judges Court Road Crossing towards South or North along Alipore Road.
5. South bound heavy goods vehicles along Baker Road will be diverted from Baker Road & Judges Court Road Crossing to further West along Judges Court Road.
6. North bound heavy good vehicles along Gopal Nagar Road will be diverted from Gopal Nagar Road & Judges Court Road Crossing to further West along Judges Court Road.
7. No heavy goods vehicle will be allowed to ply along Rakhal Das Auddy Road further North from Rakhal Das Auddy Road & Chelta Road Crossing.
8. These regulations shall be enforced in addition to the other normal restrictions on the days, which are not repugnant to the above.
