

TRAFFIC REGULATIONS

In view of the public safety and convenience in connection with **recommendation of RITES not to allow any heavy goods vehicles along Old Steel Bridge of Khidderpore**, I, Anuj Sharma, Commissioner of Police, Kolkata, in exercise of powers vested upon me under Section 115, 117, 122 & 126 M V Act, 1988 and Section 62, 62(1b) of Calcutta Police Act. 39, 39(1b) of Calcutta Suburban Police Act read with Rule No. 85, 86, 87, 88 & 93 of Rules for the Regulations of Traffic in Calcutta and Suburbs and under sub-section(1) of Section 4 of the West Bengal Traffic Regulations Act, 1965 (W B Act XV of 1965) read with Govt. of West Bengal Home (Transport) Department Order No. 7605-WT, dated the 20th July, 1965 and Govt. of West Bengal Transport Department Notification No. 3363-WT/3M- 34/99, dated the 29th April, 1999, do hereby order that movement of goods vehicles will be regulated on and from 19.08.2019 till completion of the work in the following manners:

1. Movement of Heavy Goods Vehicles over Old Steel Bridge at Khidderpore will be restricted from 19.08.2019 till completion of the work.
2. East bound heavy goods vehicles along CGR Road will be diverted from CGR Road & Satya Doctor Road Crossing towards Satya Doctor Road.
3. West bound heavy goods vehicles along CGR Road will be diverted towards New Bridge or Clyde Road from Hastings Crossing.
4. No North bound heavy goods vehicles will be allowed to ply along D H Road from D H Road & Judges Court Road Crossing, rather the vehicles will be diverted along Judges Court Road.
5. These regulations shall be enforced in addition to the other normal restrictions on the days, which are not repugnant to the above.
