

## **TRAFFIC REGULATIONS**

No. : TP/18,

Dated: 02.05.2019

In view of the public safety and convenience in connection with **proposed repairing work of Zeerut Bridge**, I, Dr. Rajesh Kumar, Commissioner of Police, Kolkata, in exercise of powers vested upon me under Section 115, 117, 122 & 126 M V Act, 1988 and Section 62, 62(1b) of Calcutta Police Act. 39, 39(1b) of Calcutta Suburban Police Act and under sub-section(1) of Section 4 of the West Bengal Traffic Regulations Act, 1965 (W B Act XV of 1965) read with Govt. of West Bengal Home (Transport) Department Order No. 7605-WT, dated the 20th July, 1965 and Govt. of West Bengal Transport Department Notification No. 3363-WT/3M- 34/99, dated the 29th April, 1999, do hereby order that movement of goods vehicles will be regulated on and from 02.05.2019 till completion of the work in the following manners:

1. Movement of Heavy Goods Vehicles over Zeerut Bridge (North bound) will be restricted from 02.05.2019 till completion of the work.
2. No Heavy Goods Vehicles will be allowed to avail Judges Court Road from D H Road/Judges Court Road crossing (Mominpore crossing). Rather, the vehicles will be diverted towards North along D H Road.
3. No Heavy Goods Vehicles will be allowed to avail Strandle Road from D H Road & Strandle Road crossing. Rather, the vehicles will be diverted towards North along D H Road.
4. Vehicular traffic may also be diverted from any of the arterial and feeder roads by traffic police on duty as and when considered necessary in the interest of the public.
5. These regulations shall be enforced in addition to the other normal restrictions on the days, which are not repugnant to the above.
