Whereas it is necessary in the interest of public safety and convenience in view of the traffic blockade for construction of new man-hole and raising work on Santoshpur Road, opposite of 84, Santoshpur Avenue, Kol-75, I, Vineet Kumar Goyal, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Kolkata, in exercise of powers vested in me under section 115, 116, 117, 122 and 126 of M.V. Act, 1988, Section 62, 62(1B) of Calcutta Police Act 1866, 39, 39(1B) of Calcutta Suburban Police Act 1866 read with rule no. 85, 86, 87, 88 and 93 of the Rules for the Regulation of Traffic in Kolkata and its Suburbs and under sub-section (1) of Section 4 of the West Bengal traffic regulation Act, 1965 (W.B. Act XV of 1965) read with Govt. of West Bengal Home (Transport) Deptt. Order no. 7605-WT, Dated- 20<sup>th</sup> July 1965 and Govt. of West Bengal in Transport Deptt. Notification No. 3363-WT/3M/34/99, dated- the 29<sup>th</sup> April, 1999 do hereby order that vehicular circulation pattern for partial closure along the middle of the road just opposite of 84, Santoshpur Avenue, will be regulated/diverted in the following manner:

**Circulation Plan / Diversion of Buses, Goods vehicles & other big vehicles:**

Govt. Bus Route like AC-9, S-9, MW-1 and Private Bus Route No. 1A, 1B, Santoshpur - BBD Bag Mini Bus along with other big buses as well as HGV's and MGV's those intend to reach Sulekha Crossing from Ajoynagar Crossing on E.M. Bypass via Santoshpur Avenue will avail further south along E.M. Bypass – Patuli Crossing – 45 Bus Stand – Right Turn to avail Raja S.C. Mollick Road – Sulekha Crossing. Similarly those big vehicles which intend to reach Ajoynagar Crossing on E.M. Bypass via Santoshpur Avenue from Sulekha Crossing will avail further south – 45 Bus Stand – Patuli Crossing – E.M. Bypass.

These will come into force with immediate effect and will continue for seven (07) days from the date of commencement of work.
